BERT HAMMEL DIRECTOR

Bert Hammel, head coach of the Merrimack College Men's Basketball team will be starting his 29th year as director of the Merrimack College Boys basketball school. Coach Hammel's commitment to each participant is to have them learn about the game's basic fundamentals, compete in game situations, meet new friends and have fun. This philosophy has made the Merrimack College Basketball School one of the best schools in the area. Hammel started his coaching career as an assistant at Merrimack College before joining the Milwaukee Bucks as a head scout in 1980. He returned to Merrimack as head coach in 1981 and is currently in his 28th year.

JOE GALLO ASSISTANT DIRECTOR:

Joe Gallo begins his third season on the Merrimack men's basketball coaching staff. He rejoins the program following a one-year stint as men's basketball assistant varsity coach at Princeton Day High School in Princeton, N.J. He also served as a substitute teacher. A two-year letterwinner at Princeton Day High School where he was also a Dean's List student, Gallo guided the team to the New Jersey Prep 'A' State Championship in 1999. He was named team MVP as a senior and was also an all-state prep selection. He transferred to Merrimack College in 2001 following one year at Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts, where he garnered MASCAN All-Rookie Team honors. Gallo, who possesses a degree in business management, resides in North Andover.
